Storage Design Tips

When looking at your storage requirements, keep this in mind;

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- If building a new warehouse, involve your rack supplier at the design phase so that things like warehouse size, lighting and slab cutting are designed around the rack. It eliminates dead space and reduces down time by not having to get the electrician back to move lights
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- When organizing your storage area, keep everyday items in the zone (shoulder to waist) and heavier items lower (don't put heavy items above shoulder height) and lighter, rainy day, might need it one day, stuff on the top shelf.
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- Take a drawing of your existing floor plan to your shelving supplier for ideas on what will fit. Make sure you mark doors, windows, switchboards, firehoses, powerpoints, overhead obstacles on the plan.
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- Consider the weights you will be storing and also possible future uses for the rack. It may be worth buying heavier or taller shelving or racking to improve its usability down the track
